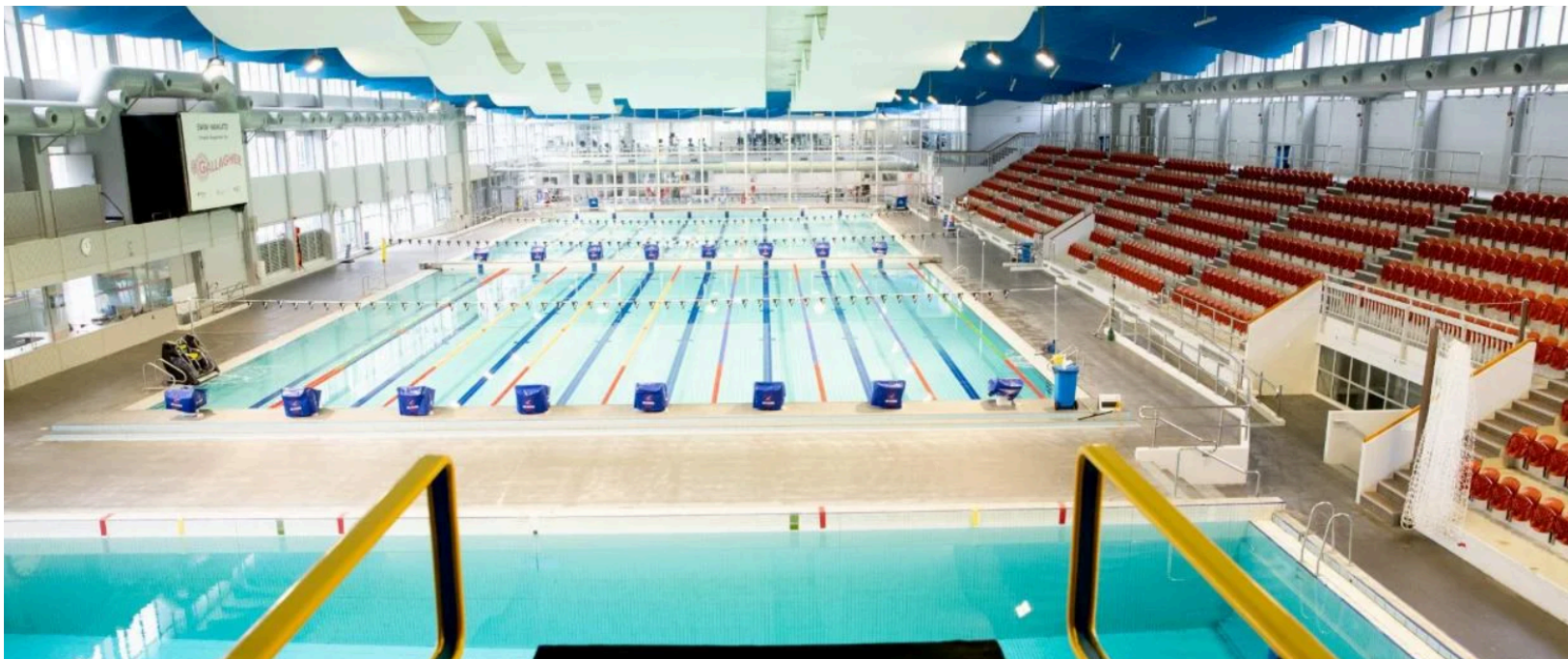


## Welcome to Hamilton!
